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

## **Slovenian Higher Education Area**

#### **Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)**

6 universities (3 public + 3 private) and 1 international association of universities (EMUNI)

41 independent higher educational institutions

969 study programmes

72.130 students (2020/21)

#### **Higher Vocational Colleges**

49 higher vocational colleges - 28 state in 21 private

10.564 students (2020/21)

#### External stakeholders – decision making

Agency Council is the **highest decision-making** body of the Agency.

- 11 members:
- 3 members => Rectors Conference (4 biggest univiersities),
- 1 member => association of independent HEIs,
- 1 member => association of higher vocational colleges,
- 2 members => organisation of students,
- 1 member => representative unions in the HE area,
- 1 member => employers' association,
- 2 members => the Government of the Republic of Slovenia.

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How does the Agency Council include the stakeholders in their tasks?

Rules of Procedure => Public proceedings for new acts or changes of existing acts

## **Agency COUNCIL**

## **External stakeholders - procedures**

Groups of independent experts consisting of at least three members, at least one of whom shall be a **foreign expert** and one **a student**.

A mandatory two-part training (independency!).

Regular trainings and coordinative meetings.

Revision of experts every five years.
